“PARA ESTABLECER LA POLITICA PUBLICA DEL MUNICIPIO DE ARROYO AL IMPLEMENTAR EL SISTEMA COMPLEMENTERIO DE PARATRANSITO DEL PROGRAMA DE TRANSPORTACION COLECTIVA Y PARA OTROS FINES”.

POR CUANTO: El Municipio de Arroyo es una entidad gubernamental regida por la Ley 81 del 30 de agosto de 1991, según enmendada, conocida como Ley de Municipios Autónomos y recipiente de fondos estatales y federales.

POR CUANTO: La Ley de Americanos con Impedimentos de 1990 (American with Disabilities Act” – ADA por sus siglas en inglés), según enmendada exige que los Municipios que interesen implementar un Sistema de Transportación Colectiva tienen que implementar un Servicio Complementario de Para tránsito para aquellas personas con impedimentos o deficiencias en el desarrollo.

POR CUANTO: El 49 CFR Parte 37, Sección 37.131 (a) define los requisitos de área de servicio. El Servicio Complementario de Para tránsito debe proveerse a las personas elegibles para cualesquiera viajes que tengan origen y destino dentro del área de servicio según definido por las reglamentaciones. El área básica de servicio es el corredor central de la ruta fija que se extiende 3/4 de milla para cualquier lado de la ruta.

POR CUANTO: El Municipio de Arroyo ha preparado un documento titulado **Plan de Servicio Complementario de Para tránsito** para cumplir con la reglamentación vigente y ofrecer el servicio de acuerdo con las leyes establecidas.

POR TANTO: **ORDENASE POR LA LEGISLATURA MUNICIPAL DE ARROYO, PUERTO RICO, LO SIGUIENTE:**

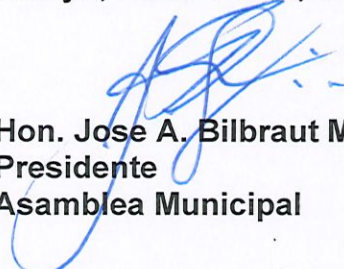
SECCION 1RA: Se establece por medio de esta Ordenanza la Política Pública del Municipio de Arroyo al implementar el **Plan de Servicio Complementario de Para tránsito**

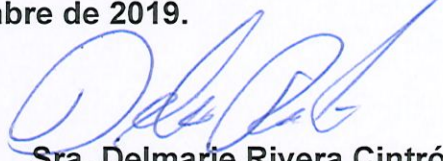

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 05

SERIES: 2019-2020

TO ESTABLISH THE PUBLIC POLICY OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ARROYO BY IMPLEMENTING THE PARATRANSITE COMPLEMENTARY SYSTEM OF THE COLLECTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS: The Municipality of Arroyo is a government entity governed by Law 81 of August 30, 1991, as amended, known as the Autonomous Municipalities Act and recipient of state and federal funds.

WHEREAS: The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), as amended requires that Municipalities interested in implementing a Collective Transportation System must implement a Complementary Transit Service for those with disabilities or developmental deficiencies.

WHEREAS: The 49 CFR Part 37, Section 37.131 (a) defines the service area requirements. The Complementary Transit Service must be provided to eligible persons for any trips that have origin and destination within the service area as defined by the regulations. The basic service area is the central corridor of the fixed route that extends 3/4 of a mile to either side of the route.

WHEREAS: The Municipality of Arroyo has prepared a document entitled Supplementary Service Plan for Transit to comply with current regulations and offer the service in accordance with established laws.

THEREFORE: BE ORDERED BY THE MUNICIPAL LEGISLATURE OF ARROYO, PUERTO RICO, THE FOLLOWING:

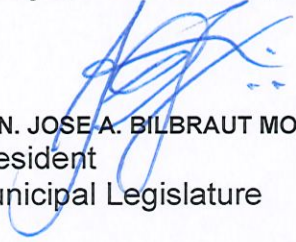
SECTION 1st: The Public Policy of the Municipality of Arroyo is established through this Ordinance by implementing the Supplementary Service Plan for Transit

SECTION 2nd: This Ordinance, because it is necessary and of an urgent nature, will govern immediately after the approval of the Municipal Legislature and be signed by the Mayor, Honorable Eric Bachier Román.

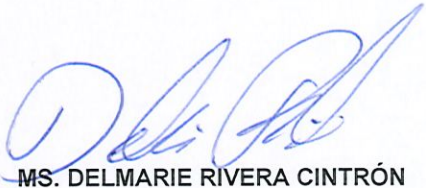

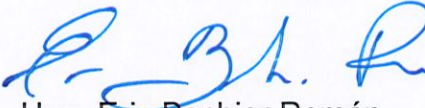

TO ESTABLISH THE PUBLIC POLICY OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ARROYO REGARDING THE TESTS FOR THE DETECTION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACCORDING TO THE FEDERAL REGULATIONS OF THE FEDERAL ADMINISTRATION OF COLLECTIVE TRANSPORTATION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS:

The Municipality of Arroyo is a government entity governed by Law 81 of August 30, 1991, as amended, known as the Autonomous Municipalities Act and recipient of state and federal funds.

WHEREAS:

Law 81 of August 30, 1991, as amended requires that all officials and employees of the Municipality and the Municipal Legislature must be physically and mentally qualified to perform the functions and duties of their respective positions while the health and safety of these public servants is protected, in addition, The Federal Law, "Omnibus Transportation Employee Testing Act of 1991, as amended, requires that municipalities that receive federal funds establish a public policy to implement Federal Administration regulations of traffic regarding drug use and alcohol abuse and the Drug - Free Workplace Act of November 18, 1988, as amended, and Administrative Order 90-1, require that municipalities and public and private entities maintain the place of drug and alcohol free employment.

WHEREAS:

The Municipality of Arroyo is a recipient of federal funds from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

WHEREAS:

The Municipality of Arroyo is in the process of establishing a free Collective Transportation Program in the Urban Area using federal funds from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

WHEREAS:

The Federal Law, "Omnibus Transportation Employee Testing Act of 1991, requires that municipalities that receive federal funds from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) establish a public policy to implement Federal Administration regulations of traffic regarding drug use and alcohol abuse.

WHEREAS:

The Municipality of Arroyo has prepared a document entitled Public Policy of the Municipality of Arroyo Regarding Drug Testing and Alcohol Abuse According to the Regulations

of the Federal Collective Transportation Administration. Arroyo Municipality Drug / Alcohol Procedures Manual, according to the Federal Collective Transportation Administration (FTA) Regulations subsidized with funds from the Highway Authority and the Federal Transit Administration, to comply with current regulations and provide officials and employees of the Municipality and the Municipal Legislature a drug and alcohol free employment area for their better living and safety.

THEREFORE:

BE ORDERED BY THE MUNICIPAL LEGISLATURE OF ARROYO, PUERTO RICO, THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 1st:

The Public Policy of the Municipality of Arroyo is established through this Ordinance by implementing the Public Policy of the Municipality of Arroyo Regarding Drug Testing and Alcohol Abuse According to the Regulations of the Federal Collective Transportation Administration.

SECTION 2nd:

This Ordinance as necessary and of an urgent nature, will be in force immediately after the approval of the Municipal Legislature and be signed by the Mayor, Honorable Eric Bachier Román.

SECTION 3rd:

This Ordinance does not conflict with any other ordinance related to the Municipal Drug and Alcohol Abuse Regulation, in that this Ordinance is exclusive for those employees directly assigned to the Collective Transportation Project subsidized with funds from the Highway Authority and the Federal Transit Administration

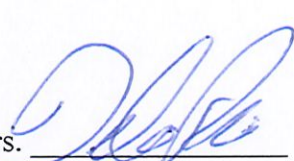
SECTION 4th:

Copy of this Ordinance, duly certified, will be sent to the Secretary of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, to the Federal Coordination Office of the Highway Authority, to the Director of Human Resources of the Municipality of Arroyo, to the Municipal Secretariat of the Municipality of Arroyo and the Board of Auctions.

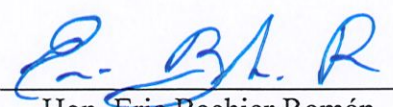
